6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state election campaigns."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 15.13.040(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) Each candidate shall make a full report, upon a form pre-
10 scribed by the commission, listing the date and amount of all expendi-
11 tures made by the candidate, the total amount of all contributions,
12 including all funds contributed by the candidate himself, and for all
13 contributions in excess of \$1,000 [\$100] in the aggregate a year, the
14 name, address, principal occupation, and employer of the contributor and
15 the date and amount contributed by each contributor. The report shall
16 be filed in accordance with sec. 110 of this chapter and shall be certi-
17 fied correct by the candidate or campaign treasurer.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 15.13.040(b)(2) is amended to read:

19 (2) the aggregate amount of all contributions made to it;
20 and, for all contributions in excess of \$1,000 [\$100] in the aggregate a
21 year, the name, address, principal occupation, and employer of the
22 contributor, and the date and amount contributed by each contributor;
23 and

24 * Sec. 3. AS 15.13.040(d)(1) is amended to read:

25 (1) any contribution of cash, goods or services valued at
26 more than \$1,000 [\$100] a year to any group or candidate; or

27 * Sec. 4. AS 15.13.060(c) is amended to read:

28 (c) Each candidate shall file the name and address of the campaign
29 treasurer with the commission no later than 15 [SEVEN] days after the

1 date of filing his declaration of candidacy or his nominating petition.
2 The name of the candidate may be placed on the ballot by the lieutenant
3 governor or municipal clerk only if the candidate has complied with this
4 subsection.
