6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the motor vehicle license tax."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.10.210 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (b) A motor vehicle owned by a person who presents written proof,
10 in the form of an affidavit signed by a physician licensed to practice
11 in this state, that he is 70 per cent medically handicapped or that he
12 is disabled to the extent that special consideration should be given by
13 the public with respect to the parking or standing in designated spaces
14 is exempt from the license tax and shall be issued a special registra-
15 tion plate which displays the standard handicap symbol (the wheelchair
16 logo).

17 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

18 Sec. 28.10.212. TRANSFER OF SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES. When a
19 vehicle with special registration plates displaying the handicap symbol
20 is sold, the special plates remain with the person to whom they are
21 issued. The department shall authorize the special plates to be used on
22 any other vehicle owned by the handicapped person upon that person's
23 written application.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.215(b) is amended to read:

25 (b) Proof of disablement or medical handicap for the purpose of
26 this section shall be given as specified in sec. 210(b) [200(b)(11)] of
27 this chapter.

28 * Sec. 4. AS 28.10.200(b)(11) is repealed.
