6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the motor vehicle license tax."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.10.200(b)(9) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 (9) a registrant who is a disabled veteran receiving at least
10 70 per cent disability compensation may register one passenger motor
11 vehicle, as defined in sec. 210(b) of this chapter, a year without
12 charge;

13 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.210 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

14 (b) A passenger motor vehicle owned by a person who presents
15 written proof, in the form of an affidavit signed by a physician li-
16 censed to practice in this state, that he is 70 per cent medically
17 handicapped or that he is disabled to the extent that special considera-
18 tion should be given by the public with respect to the parking or
19 standing in designated spaces is exempt from the license tax and shall
20 be issued one set of special registration plates displaying a symbol
21 designated by the department. As used in this subsection "passenger
22 motor vehicle" means those motor vehicles which are not designed, used,
23 or maintained primarily for the transportation of passengers or property
24 for hire and pickup trucks or vans which do not exceed 6,000 pounds,
25 unladen weight, and which are not used or maintained for transportation
26 of passengers or property for hire or other commercial use.

27 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

28 Sec. 28.10.212. TRANSFER OF SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES. When a
29 vehicle with special registration plates displaying the handicap symbol

1 is sold, the special plates remain with the person to whom they are
2 issued. The department shall authorize the special plates to be used on
3 any other passenger motor vehicle as defined by sec. 210(b) of this
4 chapter which is owned by the handicapped person upon that person's
5 written application.

6 * Sec. 4. AS 28.10.215(b) is amended to read:

7 (b) Proof of disablement or medical handicap for the purpose of
8 this section shall be given as specified in sec. 210(b) [200(b)(11)] of
9 this chapter.

10 * Sec. 5. AS 28.10.350(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) When the owner of a registered vehicle transfers or assigns
12 his title or interest, the registration of the vehicle expires, and,
13 except as provided in sec. 212 of this chapter, [BUT] the registration
14 plates shall remain on the vehicle. The owner shall endorse an assign-
15 ment and warranty of title upon the certificate of title for the vehicle
16 with a statement of all liens or encumbrances, and he shall deliver the
17 certificate of title and certificate of registration to the transferee
18 at the time of delivering the vehicle, except as provided in sec. 380 of
19 this chapter.

20 * Sec. 6. AS 28.10.200(b)(11) is repealed.
