6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to judicial compensation; and pro-
7 viding for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (a) The chief justice and each associate justice shall receive
11 \$52,992 annually as compensation. The compensation is payable monthly
12 in 12 equal installments. Compensation of the chief justice or of an
13 associate justice shall not be diminished during his term of office,
14 unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

16 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$48,576 annually as
17 compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments. The compensa-
18 tion of a judge shall not be diminished during his term of office,
19 unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

20 * Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

21 (a) Each district court judge shall receive \$41,068 annually as
22 compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments. The compensa-
23 tion of a judge may not be diminished during his term of office, unless
24 by general law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

25 * Sec. 4. This Act is retroactive to October 14, 1976.

26 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
27 070(c).
