6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to club licenses for sale of intoxi-
7 cating liquors."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.10.070 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 04.10.070. CLUB LICENSE. A club license gives to clubs,
11 fraternal organizations, and patriotic organizations, that have a state
12 or national charter, and that have been so incorporated and active for a
13 period of two years or more, the right to sell intoxicating liquors to
14 members and their families only in their club rooms. The club license
15 fee is \$400, except that where any club has certified to the board that
16 the gross sales of intoxicating liquor for the preceding year were less
17 than \$5,000 the club license fee is \$200. For purposes of this section
18 the term "member" as it applies to patriotic organizations includes
19 military personnel on active duty in uniform.
