6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to liability for the destruction of  
7 property by minors."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 34.50.020(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person, municipal corporation, association, village, school  
11 district or religious or charitable organization, incorporated or un-  
12 incorporated, may recover damages in a civil action in an amount not to  
13 exceed \$5,000 [\$2,000] and court costs, from either parent or both  
14 parents or the legal guardian or person having the legal custody of an  
15 unemancipated minor under the age of 18 years, who negligently [MALI-  
16 CIOUSLY OR WILFULLY] destroys real or personal property belonging to the  
17 person, municipal corporation, association, village, school district or  
18 religious or charitable organization. If a juvenile's name is not  
19 disclosed because of involvement in a criminal case, the court may  
20 require restitution from the parents of the juvenile to the plaintiff.
