6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for job-skill training for certain
7 employees of the Alaska marine highway system."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 19 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 65. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

11 Sec. 19.65.010. RESIDENT JOB-SKILL TRAINING FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE
12 ALASKA MARINE HIGHWAY SYSTEM. (a) The division of marine transporta-
13 tion shall establish a job-skill training program for resident employees
14 of the Alaska marine highway system. The program shall provide for, but
15 not be limited to,

16 (1) training periods of a reasonable length designed to up-
17 grade job skills at regular intervals, within the limits of available
18 funds;

19 (2) sufficient leave for out-of-state training, when no
20 in-state training is available;

21 (3) the payment of not less than three-fourths of the inci-
22 dental travel costs and other expenses related to the training period
23 for each employee;

24 (4) standards for job-skill training under this section; and

25 (5) a reimbursement requirement applying to employees who
26 terminate employment with the Alaska marine highway system within three
27 months after receiving the prescribed course of job-skill training under
28 this section.

29 (b) Employees in clerical or administrative positions with the

1 Alaska marine highway system are not eligible to participate in the
2 program established under (a) of this section.
