6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making a special appropriation to the Depart-
7 ment of Education, division of libraries and museums,
8 to provide grant funds for the construction of a com-
9 fort station for women and children at the Colony
10 Village Museum and Tourist Center; and providing for an
11 effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 * Section 1. The sum of \$46,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
14 the Department of Education, division of libraries and museums, to be avail-
15 able for a capital improvement grant for construction of a comfort station
16 for women and children at the Colony Village Museum and Tourist Center
17 located at mile 40, Glenn Highway and owned and operated by the Alaska State
18 Fair Historical, Educational and Arts Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corpora-
19 tion. This appropriation is conditioned on the requirement that the location
20 of the comfort station be in an area where visitors to the Palmer State
21 Fairgrounds can conveniently utilize the facility without charge.

22 * Sec. 2. The unexpended and unobligated portion of this appropriation
23 lapses into the general fund June 30, 1978.

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1977.
