6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to retirement benefits for state
7 employees whose jobs are abolished as a result of the
8 creation of the Department of Transportation and Public
9 Facilities."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. If the office or position of a public officer or employee is
12 rendered unnecessary and abolished as a result of the creation of the Depart-
13 ment of Transportation and Public Facilities in accordance with Executive
14 Order No. 39, and the employment of the officer or employee is terminated,
15 that officer or employee is eligible for a normal retirement pension if that
16 officer or employee has completed 15 or more years of credited service,
17 regardless of whether his employment was terminated on or after his normal
18 retirement date.
