6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for an orientation program for new
7 legislators."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 24.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 24.05.201. MEMBER ORIENTATION. The Legislative Affairs
11 Agency is responsible for arranging a program of orientation for new
12 members of the legislature. The program is to be conducted at the
13 capital during the three calendar days preceding the convening of the
14 first regular session. The program is to include briefings on admini-
15 strative matters and staff agency services, an explanation of the legis-
16 lative process and the use of the uniform rules and Mason's manual,
17 practice floor and committee sessions, and an opportunity to participate
18 in pre-session caucuses. Attendance by new members is voluntary.
19 Senior legislators and service agency staff serve as the faculty.
20 Legislators participating in the program are entitled to the regular
21 legislative per diem for each day of participation in the program.
