6 For an Act entitled: "An Act implementing the recommendations of the Alaska
7 Salary Commission relating to retirement benefits; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 39.35.125(a), (b) and (c) are amended to read:

11 (a) An elected official of a political subdivision may be included
12 in the system if, within 60 days after taking the oath of his office or
13 within 60 days after May 12, 1966

14 (1) he directs his employer in writing to make the necessary
15 deductions from his salary and to pay into the system the contributions
16 required by and for an employee under this chapter and

17 (2) notice is given the commissioner of administration in
18 writing.

19 (b) After an elected official of a political subdivision has
20 elected to be included in the system he and his employer are liable for
21 contributions whenever he is a qualified elected official of a partici-
22 pating employer.

23 (c) An elected official of a political subdivision may be included
24 retroactively in the system if he makes retroactive contributions equal
25 to what he would have made if he had elected to be included when he
26 became eligible under (a) of this section.

27 * Sec. 2. AS 39.35.125 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

28 (f) The governor, lieutenant governor, and members of the state
29 legislature are included in the system.

1 * Sec. 3. AS 39.35.680(5)(B) is amended to read:

2 (B) means the governor, lieutenant governor, and the
3 members of the Alaska State Legislature; it also means an elected
4 official of a political subdivision currently serving who elects
5 to pay contributions required of an employee and to be included in
6 the system under sec. 125 of this chapter;

7 * Sec. 4. AS 39.35.680(5)(C)(v) is amended to read:

8 (v) justices and judges of the supreme, superior
9 and district courts of Alaska; [OR THE GOVERNOR AND LIEUTENANT
10 GOVERNOR OF ALASKA; OR THE MEMBERS OF THE ALASKA STATE LEGIS-
11 LATURE;]

12 * Sec. 5. This Act is retrospective to January 1, 1977.

13 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
14 070(c).
