6 For an Act entitled: "An Act allowing a complaint to be brought as a class  
7 action with the State Commission for Human Rights."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 18.80.100 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 18.80.100. COMPLAINT. A person who believes he is aggrieved  
11 by any discriminatory conduct prohibited by this chapter may sign and  
12 file with the commission a written, verified complaint stating the name  
13 and address of the person alleged to have engaged in discriminatory  
14 conduct, and the particulars of the discrimination. The executive  
15 director may file a complaint in like manner on behalf of any person or  
16 class of persons allegedly aggrieved or injured by discriminatory conduct  
17 when an alleged discrimination comes to his attention.
