6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to teacher certification."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.020(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) A person is [NOT] eligible for a teacher certificate who  
10 [UNLESS HE] has received at least a baccalaureate degree from an insti-  
11 tution of higher education which is accredited or recognized as a candi-  
12 date for accreditation by an accrediting association officially recog-  
13 nized as such by the United States Commissioner of Education or which is  
14 listed in the most recent edition of the Education Directory: Colleges  
15 and Universities of the National Center for Education Statistics [BY A  
16 RECOGNIZED REGIONAL ACCREDITING ASSOCIATION OR APPROVED BY THE COMMIS-  
17 SIONER]. However, this subsection is not applicable to

18 (1) persons employed in the state public school system on  
19 September 1, 1962;

20 (2) persons issued an emergency certificate during a situa-  
21 tion which, in the judgment of the commissioner, requires the temporary  
22 issuance of a certificate to a person not otherwise qualified.
