6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska longevity bonus; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 47.45.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (b) A recipient who upon the direction of a physician licensed to  
11 practice in Alaska receives hospitalization or hospital outpatient care  
12 outside the state shall continue to receive bonuses during his absence,  
13 up to 90 days.

14 \* Sec. 2. AS 47.45.050 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

15 Sec. 47.45.050. DEPARTMENT HEARING. (a) The Department of Admin-  
16 istration shall by certified mail notify an applicant or recipient who  
17 has been disqualified. The notice shall inform the applicant or reci-  
18 pient of the exact reason for his disqualification and of his right to  
19 a hearing at his request under this section. The notice shall be in  
20 plain and comprehensive language. Form letters using only referral to  
21 state statutes or departmental regulations, or otherwise vague in detail,  
22 shall not be considered compliance by the department with this section.

23 (b) Upon the request of an applicant or recipient who has been  
24 disqualified, the Department of Administration shall hold an open depart-  
25 mental hearing at a reasonable time and place.
