6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to prohibitive labor representation."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 23.40 is amended by adding new sections to read:

9 Sec. 23.40.270. PROHIBITION ON REPRESENTATION OF PEACE OFFICERS  
10 BY CERTAIN LABOR ORGANIZATIONS. No labor organization which represents,  
11 or is affiliated with, any organization which represents employees in  
12 the private sector may be certified as the bargaining representative of,  
13 or otherwise represent employees in, any bargaining unit of the state or  
14 of any political subdivision of the state, which includes state troopers,  
15 police, or peace officers.

16 Sec. 23.40.280. CONTRACTS WITH LABOR ORGANIZATIONS. No labor  
17 organization which is prohibited from representing a bargaining unit of  
18 the state or a political subdivision of the state may enter into a  
19 contract with any other labor organization certified to represent, or  
20 otherwise representing, employees in the bargaining unit. Any such  
21 contract shall be null and void and shall be grounds for decertification  
22 and a refusal of the state or political subdivision of the state to deal  
23 with the otherwise eligible labor organization.
