6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the survey and improvement of state
7 land."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38.95 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 3. SURVEY AND IMPROVEMENT OF STATE LAND.

11 Sec. 38.95.100. SURVEY OF STATE LAND. A professional land surveyor
12 registered to practice under AS 08.48 shall supervise the location and
13 monumentation of boundaries, the platting, subdivision and the prepara-
14 tion and perpetuation of maps, record plats, field note records and
15 property descriptions of state land.

16 Sec. 38.95.110. IMPROVEMENTS ON STATE LAND. (a) It shall be a
17 condition of every lease, easement, right-of-way agreement or other
18 similar agreement permitting the use and improvement of state land that
19 the location, design, and construction of improvements on the land be
20 under the supervision of a professional registered to practice under AS
21 08.48. A change in the boundary of a lease, easement, right-of-way or
22 other similar agreement permitting the use and improvement of state land
23 shall be documented by a record plat.

24 (b) In (a) of this section "improvements" includes, but is not
25 limited to, onshore or offshore oil drilling or pumping operations,
26 roads, bridges, pipelines, seismic lines, logging and mining operations,
27 dams, buildings and electric power transmission lines.
