A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the survey and improvement of state
7 land."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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* Section 1. AS 38.95 is amended by adding new sections to read:

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ARTICLE 3. SURVEY AND IMPROVEMENT OF STATE LAND.

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Sec. 38.95.100. SURVEY OF STATE LAND. A professional land surveyor
12 registered to practice under AS 08.48 shall supervise the location and
13 monumentation of boundaries, the platting, subdivision and the prepara-
14 tion and perpetuation of maps, record plats, field note records and
15 property descriptions of state land.

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Sec. 38.95.110. IMPROVEMENTS ON STATE LAND. (a) The location,
17 design, and construction of publicly-financed improvements costing in
18 excess of \$100,000 on state land shall be under the supervision of a
19 professional registered to practice under AS 08.48. A change in the
20 boundary of a lease, easement, right-of-way or other similar agreement
21 permitting the use and improvement of state land shall be documented by
22 a record plat.

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(b) In (a) of this section "improvements" includes, but is not
24 limited to, onshore or offshore oil drilling or pumping operations,
25 roads, bridges, pipelines, seismic lines, logging and mining operations,
26 dams, buildings and electric power transmission lines.

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(c) In (a) of this section "publicly-financed" improvements in-
28 cludes all improvements financed by the state with state or federal
29 funds, and all improvements constructed by instrumentalities of the

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
