6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state regulation of fireworks; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 18.72.020(a)(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) the person has submitted to the state fire marshal a
11 policy, or a certified true copy of a policy, of public liability [AND
12 PRODUCTS LIABILITY] insurance, including both accident and occurrence
13 coverage, provided by the wholesale company selling to the fireworks
14 retailer, in the amount of at least \$200,000 [\$300,000] for bodily
15 injury or death and at least \$50,000 [\$100,000] property damage [, UPON
16 WHICH POLICY THE STATE AND ALL GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE]
17 and the permit holder shall be named as an insured party upon the policy
18 [ADDITIONAL INSUREDS] and the policy [WHICH] shall be continuously in
19 force while the permit holder is engaged in the retail sale of fire-
20 works, and

21 * Sec. 2. AS 18.72.030(a) is amended to read:

22 (a) A person who desires to sell fireworks at wholesale in the
23 state shall first make verified application for a license to the state
24 fire marshal on forms provided by him. The application shall be accom-
25 panied by an annual license fee of \$100 [\$500].

26 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
27 070(c).
