6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to unauthorized parking on state
7 property."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 35 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 23. UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES ON STATE PROPERTY.

11 Sec. 35.23.010. AUTHORIZATION FOR THE USE OF PARKING SPACES IN
12 STATE PARKING AREAS REQUIRED. Without authorization from the authority
13 having jurisdiction under a law of this state, no person may park or
14 leave standing a vehicle in a state-owned or state-managed parking area,
15 except in parking spaces reserved for the use of the general public and
16 posted as reserved for that use.

17 Sec. 35.23.020. ENFORCEMENT. A police officer or an employee
18 authorized by the manager of the state-owned or state-managed property
19 or a person designated for this purpose by the authority having juris-
20 diction under a law of this state may request that state or municipal
21 police come onto that property for the purpose of ticketing or impounding
22 a vehicle parked or left standing without proper authorization. Re-
23 lease of the vehicle to its owner may be accomplished under appropriate
24 municipal or state procedures which may provide that the costs of
25 ticketing or impoundment be paid before the vehicle is returned to its
26 owner.
