6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicle insurance policies."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 21.89 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 21.89.030. INSURERS TO OFFER DEDUCTIBLES. (a) An insurer  
10 doing business in this state selling or renewing a motor vehicle casualty  
11 insurance contract of the type generally known as "collision insurance"  
12 shall offer the purchaser the option of selecting deductible amounts  
13 from \$100 to \$1,000 in \$100 increments, at appropriately reduced premiums.

14 (b) An insurer doing business in the state selling or renewing a  
15 motor vehicle casualty insurance of the type generally known as "com-  
16 prehensive insurance" shall offer the purchaser the option of selecting  
17 deductible amounts of \$50, \$100, or \$150, at appropriately reduced  
18 premiums.

19 (c) An insurer violating the provisions of this section is guilty  
20 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of \$500 for  
21 each violation. In the event of a conviction the director may suspend  
22 or revoke the license of the insurer, but violation does not invalidate  
23 the insurance contract.
