8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.33.020(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) If a school board, or a private or denominational school
11 determines that a safety patrol should be established for a school, the
12 principal of the school may [SHALL] appoint pupils in the school or
13 employ adults to serve as members of the patrol.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 14.33.030(b) is amended to read:

15 (b) A pupil appointed as a patrol member shall not, under any
16 circumstances, be permitted to direct vehicular traffic or be stationed
17 in a street or highway while performing his duties.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 14.33 is amended by adding a new section to read:

19 Sec. 14.33.070. SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL FUND. (a) There is in the
20 Department of Transportation and Public Facilities a school safety pa-
21 trol fund which is an account in the general fund to receive money
22 appropriated by the legislature for the hiring of adult members of a
23 school safety patrol.

24 (b) A school district in the state shall be eligible for an
25 annual grant from the fund created by this section to be used for the
26 employment of adult members of its safety patrol. These grants may not
27 exceed 70 per cent of the total expenditure by the school district for
28 employing adult members of its safety patrol.

29 (c) The Department of Transportation and Public Facilities shall
