6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the office of the ombudsman."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 24.55.200 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 24.55.200. PUBLICATION OF RECOMMENDATIONS. Within a reason-
10 able amount of time after the ombudsman reports his opinion and recom-
11 mendations to an agency he may present his opinion and recommendations
12 to the governor, the legislature, [A GRAND JURY,] the public or any of
13 these. The ombudsman shall include with his opinion any reply made by
14 the agency.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 24.55.220 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 24.55.220. MISCONDUCT BY AGENCY PERSONNEL. If the ombudsman
17 believes there is a breach of duty or misconduct by an officer or
18 employee of an agency in the conduct of his official duties, the ombuds-
19 man shall refer the matter to the chief executive officer of the agency
20 or [, WHEN APPROPRIATE, TO A GRAND JURY OR] to another appropriate
21 official or agency.
