6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to creditable service under the
7 teachers' retirement system for professional and admin-
8 istrative personnel of the University of Alaska and the
9 community colleges."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 14.25.220(15) is amended to read:

12 (15) "teacher" or "member" means a certified teacher, certified
13 school nurse, principal, supervisor, or superintendent employed on a
14 full-time or a part-time basis in a position having duties which normally
15 require a year of service in the public schools of the state, the
16 commissioner of education, supervisors within the Department of Educa-
17 tion, [AND] all full-time or part-time basis [RESIDENT] professional and
18 administrative personnel of the University of Alaska, and all full- or
19 part-time basis professional and administrative personnel of a community
20 college employed to conduct the academic degree programs and activities
21 of the community college; in case of doubt, the administrator shall
22 finally determine whether or not a person is a teacher as defined in
23 this chapter;
