6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing state aid to local governments for
7 health facilities; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 43.18.010(i)(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) "health facility" means public health centers, maternity
12 homes and community mental health centers, facilities for the mentally
13 or physically handicapped, nursing homes and convalescent centers which
14 are licensed, when required, by the state under AS 18.20.010 - 18.20.130
15 and are owned or operated or both by a local government or by a non-
16 profit corporation or other nonprofit sponsor; the term includes
17 [EXCLUDES] facilities operated or [WHOLLY] supported by the state or the
18 federal government, but, if the local government expends less than \$800
19 on the cost of operation, maintenance and related costs for the facility,
20 the payment for that facility is reduced to an amount directly propor-
21 tional to the ratio of the expenditure to \$800.

22 * Sec. 2. AS 43.18.010(i) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

23 (3) "cost of operation, maintenance and related costs for a
24 health facility" includes compensation paid to health aides, alternate
25 health aides, and the manager of the facility.

26 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1978.
