6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring the election pamphlet to contain
7 fiscal information for ballot propositions; and pro-
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 15.57.010 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

11 (4) for each ballot proposition which may increase or de-
12 crease revenue or cost to state or local government, an impartial analy-
13 sis of the measure prepared by the division of budget and management of
14 the Office of the Governor showing the amount of any increase or de-
15 crease in revenue or cost to state or local government; the analysis
16 shall be written in clear and concise terms which will easily be under-
17 stood by the average voter, and shall avoid the use of technical terms
18 wherever possible; the analysis may contain background information,
19 including the effect of the measure on existing law and the effect of
20 enacted legislation which will become effective if the measure is adop-
21 ted, and shall generally set out in an impartial manner the information
22 which the average voter needs to understand the measure adequately. The
23 division shall, upon request, make draft copies of the analysis avail-
24 able to the public at least 30 days before final submission of the
25 analysis for publication in the election pamphlet.

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
27 070(c).

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
