6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to electrical administrators."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.40.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 08.40.010. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD. There is hereby
10 created a Board of Electrical Examiners consisting of three members who
11 are licensed electrical administrators and two members who have no
12 direct financial interest in the electrical administration field.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 08.40.040 is amended to read:

14 Sec. 08.40.040. BOARD MEETINGS. The board shall hold a regular
15 annual meeting. The board may hold special meetings at the call of the
16 chairman with prior approval of the governor. Three members, at least
17 two of whom are licensed electrical administrators, [TWO MEMBERS] con-
18 stitute a quorum.

19 * Sec. 3. AS 08.40.120 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 08.40.120. EXAMINATION OF APPLICANT. (a) Each applicant
21 shall be examined to determine his knowledge of electrical installations
22 and wiring, familiarity with the regulations contained in the National
23 Electrical Code and the National Electrical Safety Code (most recent
24 editions), as approved by the American Standards Association, other
25 installation and safety regulations approved by the American Standards
26 Association or the legislature of the State of Alaska, and his personal
27 skill and ability.

28 (b) Each applicant shall also be examined to determine his know-
29 ledge of contracting practices and his familiarity with applicable state

1 and federal contracting laws.
