6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the issuance of motor vehicle
7 operators' licenses."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.15.120 is repealed, and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 28.15.120. EXPIRATION OF LICENSE. (a) Every operator's
11 license issued after the effective date of this Act expires on the
12 licensee's birthday 25 years from his birthday preceding application,
13 except that the license shall expire on the third birthday of the licen-
14 see following the issuance of the license if the licensee is 25 years or
15 younger on that third birthday or if at any time after issuance the
16 licensee

17 (1) is over 65 years of age; or

18 (2) has been convicted in the previous two years of viola-
19 tions of the traffic laws, regulations, or ordinances of the state or
20 municipalities, which under the provisions of sec. 282 of this chapter
21 total nine points or more.

22 (b) The license may be renewed on or before its expiration upon
23 application and payment of the prescribed fee. The department may re-
24 quire an examination of the applicant in the same manner as upon the
25 original application.
