6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to school bus drivers' permits."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.15.130 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 28.15.130. SCHOOL BUS DRIVER'S PERMIT. (a) Subject to (b)
10 of this section, the department shall issue a school bus driver's permit
11 upon application and completion of driving, written and physical examina-
12 tions. The department shall require fingerprints to be taken as part of
13 the application process, under regulations it adopts. The permit expires
14 on September 1 of the year following issuance and may be renewed by sub-
15 mission to the department of a current physical examination. No person
16 may operate a school bus carrying children without a school bus driver's
17 permit. The commissioner of public safety may establish, by regulation,
18 medical standards and standards of driving conduct and proficiency gover-
19 ning the issuance or denial of school bus driver's permits.

20 (b) Unless a pardon for the conviction has been issued, no person
21 who has been convicted of a felony, assault with a dangerous weapon,
22 aggravated assault, attempted felony, or attempted assault with a danger-
23 ous weapon, by a court in this state, or by the courts of the United
24 States or of another state or territory, may be issued a school bus
25 driver's permit under this section.

26 (c) The department may refuse to renew or may revoke a school bus
27 driver's permit issued under (a) of this section for the conviction of
28 an offense specified in (b) of this section.
