6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative members of committees,  
7 boards, and commissions; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 24.05.087 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 24.05.087. TERMINATION OF INTERIM COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP. When  
12 a member of the legislature who serves on a committee created during a  
13 between session interim by either house or its presiding officers, the  
14 Legislative Council or the Legislative Budget and Audit Committee,  
15 files a declaration of candidacy for an elective office other than that  
16 of member of either house of the legislature, and he has not resigned  
17 from membership on the interim committee, his interim committee member-  
18 ship terminates on the date of filing. When a member of the legislature  
19 who is chairman of any other committee, board or commission of the state  
20 government, except a standing committee of the legislature or a special  
21 committee of the legislature which functions only while the legislature  
22 is in session, files a declaration of candidacy for an elective office  
23 other than that of member of either house of the legislature, his  
24 chairmanship terminates on the date of filing but he may remain as a  
25 member of the committee, board or commission.
