6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bilingual education; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.17.031(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
10 read:

11 (5) the number of units for bilingual education determined
12 from sec. 41(g) of this chapter as approved by the department.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17.041 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

14 (g) Bilingual education schedule:

15 Weighted ADM	No. Instructional Units
16 1 - 12	1
17 13 - 18	2
18 19 - 42	3
19 42 and over	3 plus 1 for each
	24 weighted ADM or
	21 fraction of 24
	22 weighted ADM.

23 * Sec. 3. AS 14.17.250 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

24 (19) "weighted ADM" means the number of students in average
25 daily membership in an educational program, adjusted to reflect the
26 level of service required by them in that program as determined by the
27 department.

28 * Sec. 4. AS 14.30.410(a) is amended to read:

29 (a) There is in the Department of Education a bilingual-bicultural

1 education fund which is an account in the general fund to receive
2 money appropriated by the legislature for bilingual-bicultural educa-
3 tion and to be used for bilingual-bicultural education program imple-
4 mentation and materials development [OPERATION, INCLUDING BUT NOT
5 LIMITED TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STATEWIDE BILINGUAL-BICULTURAL
6 EDUCATIONAL CENTER].

7 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1978.
