6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to grants-in-aid to municipalities and
7 associations maintaining public libraries; and pro-
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.56.050 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 14.56.050. PAYMENT OF GRANT-IN-AID. (a) A municipality or
12 an association may apply to the department for payment of a grant-in-aid
13 authorized by secs. 40 - 60 of this chapter. At the discretion of the
14 commissioner, payment of a grant-in-aid may be made in accordance with
15 regulations adopted by the department.

16 (b) A grant under (a) of this section is authorized only for the
17 purchase of books and periodicals, or other library materials.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 14.56.060 is amended to read:

19 Sec. 14.56.060. LIMITATION ON GRANT-IN-AID. The state shall pro-
20 vide assistance to a municipality providing public library services or
21 to any association incorporated under the laws of the state, for the
22 purpose of maintaining public libraries, to the extent of paying to the
23 municipality or association \$500 [A SUM EQUAL TO THE SUM WHICH THE
24 ASSOCIATION SPENDS IN PURCHASING BOOKS AND PERIODICALS FOR PUBLIC LI-
25 BRARIES IN THE STATE, NOT EXCEEDING \$250] in one year [TO EACH ASSOCIA-
26 TION,] in accordance with regulations adopted by [THE RULES OF] the
27 department.

28 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1978.
