6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending programs of state aid to municipali-  
7 ties and other recipients relating to public libraries  
8 and hospitals."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \*Section 1. AS 14.56.050 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 14.56.050. PAYMENT OF GRANT-IN-AID. (a) A municipality or  
12 an association may apply to the department for payment of a grant-in-aid  
13 authorized by secs. 40 - 60 of this chapter. At the discretion of the  
14 commissioner, payment of a grant-in-aid may be made in accordance with  
15 regulations adopted by the department.

16 (b) A grant under (a) of this section is authorized only for the  
17 purchase of books and periodicals, or other library materials.

19 Sec. 14.56.060. LIMITATION ON GRANT-IN-AID. The state shall pro-  
20 vide assistance to a municipality providing public library services or  
21 to any association incorporated under the laws of the state, for the  
22 purpose of maintaining public libraries, to the extent of paying to the  
23 municipality or association \$1,000 [A SUM EQUAL TO THE SUM WHICH THE  
24 ASSOCIATION SPENDS IN PURCHASING BOOKS AND PERIODICALS FOR PUBLIC LI-  
25 BRARIES IN THE STATE, NOT EXCEEDING \$250] in one year [TO EACH ASSOCIA-  
26 TION,] in accordance with regulations adopted by [THE RULES OF] the  
27 department.

28 \* Sec. 3. AS 43.18.010(j) is amended to read:

29 (j) If construction of a facility began after January 1, 1968 and

1 state matching aid for construction approved for payment to the local  
2 government or other facility sponsor constitutes less than 25 per cent  
3 of the total project cost, the state shall pay to the local government  
4 or other facility sponsor each fiscal year a sum equal to \$2,500 a bed  
5 for the maximum number of beds provided for in the construction design  
6 of the facility or five per cent of the total project cost, whichever is  
7 greater. State aid provided for in this subsection shall continue until  
8 the local government or other facility sponsor has received an amount  
9 which, combined with state matching money for construction of the  
10 facility, equals 25 per cent of the total project cost. No funds  
11 received for construction shall be used for any other purpose.

12 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1978.
