6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation for state officers and  
7 employees not covered by a collective bargaining agree-  
8 ment; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 39.27.011(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 (a) The following annual basic salary schedule is approved as the  
12 pay plan for classified and partially exempt employees in the executive  
13 branch of the state government who are not members of a collective  
14 bargaining unit established under the authority of the Public Employment  
15 Relations Act:

15 \* Sec. 2. It is the intent of the legislature that certain public  
16 officers as set out in secs. 6 - 9 of this Act, the permanent and temporary  
17 employees of the judicial branch (other than judicial officers), and the  
18 permanent employees of the legislative branch, receive cost-of-living adjust-  
19 ments comparable to those received by the classified and partially exempt  
20 employees under sec. 1 of this Act.

21 \* Sec. 3. The pay plan for University of Alaska employees shall be  
22 determined by the Board of Regents pursuant to AS 14.40.170(2). It is the  
23 intent of the legislature that the pay plan shall be applied in some combina-  
24 tion of base salary schedule increases or bonus payments or both so that the  
25 present disparity between the salaries of staff on the "President's staff  
26 schedule" and the "Deans and Directors schedule", and those on the "Academic,  
27 Professional and Technical schedule" and "classified salary schedule" is not  
28 increased. It is not intended that the pay plan cost-of-living adjustments  
29 necessarily be totally distributed or allocated equally among the four salary

1 schedules, or that distribution of any amount necessarily be made to each  
2 schedule or to each employee.

5 COVERED. The commission shall conduct an on-going review of compensa-  
6 tion and retirement benefits for members of the legislature; the gover-  
7 nor; the lieutenant governor; commissioners, deputy commissioners, and  
8 division directors of each executive department; [MEMBERS OF THE ALASKA  
9 PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION; MEMBERS OF THE ALASKA PIPELINE COMMISSION;  
10 MEMBERS OF THE ALASKA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION; MEMBERS OF THE ALASKA  
11 COMMERCIAL FISHERIES ENTRY COMMISSION;] and the judiciary, to determine
