6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Public Utilities Com-
7 mission; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.25.120 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (10) the executive director and deputy director of the Alaska
11 Public Utilities Commission.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 42.05.121(a) is amended to read:

13 (a) The commission may employ an executive director who shall have
14 had at least five years of experience in [AN ADMINISTRATIVE CAPACITY AND
15 WHO IS EXPERIENCED IN] public utility management or regulation, law,
16 accounting, or an allied field. The executive director may be one of
17 the commission members. The commission may employ engineers, hearing
18 officers, experts, clerks, accountants, and other agents and assistants
19 it considers necessary. The executive director, if not a member of the
20 commission, and his deputy are in the partially exempt service under AS
21 39.25.120. All [AND ALL] other employees and agents of the commission,
22 other than legal counsel, are in the classified service under AS 39.25.-
23 100 [39.25]. The combined salary of an executive director who is a
24 member of the commission may not exceed that of a superior court judge.

25 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
