For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to regular sessions of the legisla-  
7 ture."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 24.05.150 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 24.05.150. ADJOURNMENT. (a) No later than the 15th day of  
11 each regular session, the legislative council shall introduce, through  
12 the rules committee of each house, a concurrent resolution establishing  
13 the maximum length of the session. The maximum length prescribed in the  
14 resolution is effective and binding unless rejected by a majority vote  
15 of each house on or before the 30th day of the session. The maximum  
16 length may be amended on or before the 30th day of the session by a  
17 majority vote of each house. The maximum length may be amended after  
18 the 30th day of the session only by a two-thirds vote of each house.  
19 Neither house may adjourn before the date established in the resolution  
20 unless the other house concurs.

(b) Neither house may recess for longer than three days unless the  
22 other concurs.
