HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 17
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to conducting the business of the
district courts in the evening.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the business of the district courts of the State of Alaska
requires that a substantial number of the public personally appear in court
or in the office of the court clerk; and

WHEREAS appearance in court involves substantial hardship for those per-
sons who are otherwise needed at home or at work; and

WHEREAS an appearance in court can be especially burdensome for low-
income persons;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully
requests the supreme court to ascertain what business of the district courts,
if conducted in the evening, would further the convenience of the largest
number of people and to direct the district courts to conduct that business
in the evening.
