6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS A. Teresa Ripley has recently retired from 43 years of teaching
8 in Alaska; and

9 WHEREAS, beginning in 1933, Mrs. Ripley served as a teacher with the
10 Bureau of Indian Affairs in Buckland, Point Hope, Wrangell, and finally
11 Mt. Edgecumbe where she served after 1941; and

12 WHEREAS she served the state as a member of the State Mental Health
13 Planning Commission, Alaska Purchase Centennial Committee, Sitka Economic
14 Planning Commission, American Association of University Women, Beta Sigma Phi,
15 Pioneers of Alaska, St. Gregory's Catholic Church Women, Alaska Heart Associ-
16 ation, Emblem Club, and Delta Kappa Gamma; and

17 WHEREAS, in addition to performing public service, Mrs. Ripley with her
18 husband raised two fine sons, J. Justin Ripley, Superior Court Judge in the
19 Third Judicial District in Anchorage, and J. Gregory Ripley, an industrial
20 engineer for the Boeing Company in Seattle;

22 appreciation and congratulations for a job well done to A. Teresa Ripley upon
23 her retirement, and wishes her the best of luck in the future.
