Creating an interim oversight committee

for review of business management practices

and fiscal procedures of the University of

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the University of Alaska has experienced substantial difficulty

11

which, at least in part, is a result of business management practices and

12

fiscal procedures of the university; and

WHEREAS there are various areas of operations which have contributed to

14

this problem; and

WHEREAS an interim committee charged by the legislature with oversight

16

of these problems, with subcommittees to exercise a more specific oversight

17

of particular problem areas, would contribute to the solution of these pro-

18

blems;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the presiding officers

20

of both houses jointly appoint a committee charged with oversight of the

21

business management practices and the fiscal procedures of the University of

22

Alaska; that the committee consist of 20 members comprised of five members

23

from each house of the legislature, five members from the Board of Regents of

24

the University of Alaska, and five members from the business community of the

25

State of Alaska; that the committee have the function of exercising oversight

26

and review of business management practices and the fiscal procedures of the

27

University of Alaska, and create from its membership subcommittees with

28

specific responsibilities in areas in which the committee feels more detailed

29

oversight would be useful; it is intended that this committee have no function

1 in overseeing the academic practices and policies of the university, nor shall
2 the committee have any administrative or executive authority; and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee, from time to time as it considers
4 desirable, report its recommendations to the University of Alaska and to the
5 Legislature and submit a report to the Second Session of the Tenth Legislature
6 of its activities and recommendations on the date that the Second Session
7 convenes; and be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee continue during the life of the
9 Tenth State Legislature, and, upon adjournment of the First Session, that the
10 committee become an interim committee reporting to the Legislative Council.
