5 Relating to uniform collection procedures
6 for overdue loans approved by state
7 agencies.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS a review by the Legislative Affairs Agency of debt collection
10 functions of the several state departments administering loan programs and
11 recent program audits completed by the legislative audit division have dis-
12 closed unacceptable delinquency rates in several state loan programs; and

13 WHEREAS the Governor's Management and Efficiency Review recognizes that
14 high delinquency rates are a continuing obstacle to improvement of the admin-
15 istration of several loan programs; and

16 WHEREAS, through direct and concerted effort, the delinquency rate of
17 loans issued by the Department of Commerce and Economic Development has been
18 reduced; and

19 WHEREAS, while revolving loan programs are administered by several
20 departments, their characteristics do not appear to preclude a compatible or
21 uniform arrangement for the routine debt collection functions;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
23 respectfully requested to review, with the commissioners of each department
24 having responsibility for revolving loan programs and the directors of the
25 programs, and to submit a report to the Tenth Legislature, not later than
26 the 10th day of the Second Session, examining the feasibility of establishing
27 a statewide collection agency or debt collection model uniformly applicable
28 among all state departments to reduce the volume of outstanding overdue loans
29 and to maintain the delinquency rate of loans at an acceptable level.
