2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 46
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to Eunice M. Berglund.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Eunice M. Berglund provided public health nursing services on
8 a continuing itinerant basis from November 1953 to December 1955 to the
9 villages of Allakaket, Anaktuvuk Pass, Arctic Village, Beaver, Bettles,
10 Bettles Field, Ft. Yukon, Stevens Village, Venetie, Nenana, Eagle, Circle,
11 Circle Hot Springs, Central, Minto, Rampart, Manley Hot Springs, Huslia,
12 Hughes, Birch Creek and Chalkyitsik; and

13 WHEREAS she rendered public health nursing services on an on-going basis
14 from February 1956 to March 1961 to the villages of Brevig Mission, Elim,
15 Gambell, Little Diomedea, Savoonga, Shishmaref, Teller, Wales, White Mountain,
16 Golovin and Solomon; and

17 WHEREAS she brought public health nursing services on a routine schedule
18 from January 1961 to February 1967 to Igiugig, Iliamna (Newhalen), Kokhanok,
19 Nondalton, Pedro Bay, Anchor Point, Clam Gulch, Cohoe, English Bay, Kasilof,
20 Nikolaevsk, Ninilchik, Port Graham, and Seldovia, and continued serving the
21 last nine communities from March 1967 to March 1977; and

22 WHEREAS she willingly and without complaint carried out the responsibi-
23 lities of a heavy, demanding service which frequently required working far
24 into the night and over weekends in response to the health needs of the
25 people; and

26 WHEREAS she continued to travel to villages in small planes in order to
27 bring health services to the village residents, despite a plane crash in
28 1965 when she was seriously injured and incapacitated for approximately ten
29 months; and

1 WHEREAS she has made an outstanding contribution in improving and main-
2 taining the health of many people in rural Alaska;

3 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature commends the dedicated
4 and distinguished service of Eunice M. Berglund on the occasion of her retire-
5 ment, March 15, 1977 from the Section of Nursing, Division of Public Health,
6 Alaska Department of Health and Social Services.
