5 Commending the State Investment Advisory  
6 Committee.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the State Investment Advisory Committee has undertaken and  
9 completed a study of alternative structures by which the Alaska Permanent  
10 Fund could be managed; and

11 WHEREAS the committee met with officials of the Alberta Heritage Trust  
12 Fund and with investment officers experienced with similar funds in various  
13 parts of the world; and

14 WHEREAS consultants to the committee worked with all members of the  
15 committee in a spirit of cooperation; and

16 WHEREAS the committee met six times and otherwise worked diligently over  
17 a seven-month period, honestly seeking numerous points of view; and

18 WHEREAS their work and recommendations provide the legislature with a  
19 starting point for an intelligent debate on the structure of the permanent  
20 fund;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it commends the  
22 members of the State Investment Advisory Committee for devoting their time,  
23 energy and knowledge to the study; that Sterling Gallagher, Commissioner  
24 of Revenue, and James Edenso, Deputy Commissioner of Revenue for the Trea-  
25 sury, are to be commended for their leadership in the production of a thought-  
26 ful proposal for the management of the Alaska Permanent Fund; and that the  
27 consultants to the committee are to be praised for bringing an unusual  
28 enthusiasm to their tasks.
