4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Encouraging Alaska citizens' participation
6 in the seventh annual Walk for Hope.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Alaska faces problems of great magnitude in the areas of service
9 to the mentally retarded and handicapped citizens of the state; and

10 WHEREAS Hope Cottages, Inc., is the largest not-for-profit community
11 based organization dedicated to providing homes and quality programs to these
12 Alaskans, enabling them to obtain the care and treatment to develop their
13 maximum potential socially as well as mentally; and

14 WHEREAS total citizen involvement throughout the state is desirable and
15 essential; and

16 WHEREAS Hope Cottages, Inc., is sponsoring its seventh annual Walk for
17 Hope in Anchorage and other Alaskan communities to raise funds for the con-
18 tinuation of services for the mentally retarded and handicapped citizens of
19 our state; and

20 WHEREAS all of the money raised will remain in Alaska to enhance this
21 cause; and

22 WHEREAS the Alaska Legislature has continuously supported the Walk for
23 Hope in past years;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges all citizens of
25 our great state to participate, thereby showing their concern for less for-
26 tunate citizens, in the seventh annual Walk for Hope to be held on May 7,
27 1977; and be it

28 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to proclaim
29 May 7, 1977 a "Day of Hope".
