3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a cost analysis of keeping the
6 capital in Juneau.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the citizens of the State of Alaska have voted to move the capi-
9 tal; and

10 WHEREAS the citizens are entitled to know the cost of such a move before
11 it takes place; and

12 WHEREAS the true cost of the move is only that portion over and above
13 the cost of keeping the capital in its present location; and

14 WHEREAS, the Legislature has directed the New Capital Site Planning
15 Commission to conduct a cost analysis for the new capital site, but has given
16 no direction regarding the cost of keeping the present location;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
18 the Governor to direct the New Capital Site Planning Commission to conduct a
19 cost analysis of keeping the capital in its present location; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED that the analysis be based on assumptions identical to
21 those used in preparing the cost analysis for relocating to a new capital.
