7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Rule 51, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides  
9 that adjournments or recesses for longer than three days must be approved by  
10 adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority of the full membership of  
11 each house; and

12 WHEREAS it is critical for the members of the legislature to personally  
13 present their views on the "d-2 land" proposals now before Congress;

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the legislature is adjourned for the period April 15  
15 to April 19, 1978, for the purpose of traveling to Washington, D.C. so that  
16 members can present their views on the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act  
17 "d-2" land proposals that are presently before Congress.
