3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

5 Relating to the Juneau-Douglas Community
6 College and the University of Alaska
7 Juneau.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS a decision is pending before the Board of Regents of the Univer-
10 sity of Alaska which would have the effect of changing the structure of the
11 existing Juneau-Douglas Community College and the University of Alaska Juneau
12 by creating a new structure which would consist of a four-year college with a
13 vocational education complement to be administered separately; and

14 WHEREAS both the community college and the senior college would be in-
15 corporated in the new structure; and

16 WHEREAS the continuing existence of the Juneau-Douglas Community College
17 as an administratively separate unit from the University of Alaska Juneau
18 is compatible with a four-year college and serves a needed educational pur-
19 pose; and

20 WHEREAS the legislature acknowledges there are coordination problems
21 between the two existing delivery structures; and

22 WHEREAS abolishing the existing structures and creating a single new
23 structure is an overreaction to the coordination problems;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
25 the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska to continue the existence of
26 the Juneau-Douglas Community college as a separate entity but to take action
27 to ensure that the coordination between the entities is improved.
