CS HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 135
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Annulling a regulation of the Alaska Public Utilities Commission pertaining to the allocation of property costs, revenues, expenses, taxes and reserves of each utility certified by the commission.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS under AS 44.62.320 the legislature may annul administrative regulations of an agency by concurrent resolution adopted by a vote of both houses; and

WHEREAS the Alaska Public Utilities Commission has adopted by reference the procedures and practices set out in the February 1971 edition of the Separations Manual, published by the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners, for use in allocating property costs, revenues, expenses, taxes, and reserves of each utility certified by the commission, as well as in determining which of the foregoing are subject to the jurisdiction of the commission; and

WHEREAS, under the practices and procedures outlined in this manual, property costs, revenues, expenses, taxes and reserves cannot be fairly determined for long lines carriers operating in Alaska, and this imposes an undue burden on long lines carriers in Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that 3 AAC 48.430 is annulled.
