5 Requesting the Postmaster General to im-
6 prove postal service in the Muldoon Ser-
7 vice Area of Anchorage.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the population of the Muldoon Service Area of Anchorage has
10 grown rapidly, and continues to do so; and

11 WHEREAS the only postal services presently located in the Muldoon area
12 consist of one contract station; and

13 WHEREAS this facility is no longer adequate to meet the postal service
14 needs of the area residents;

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Honorable
16 Benjamin F. Bailar, Postmaster General of the United States, is requested to
17 take steps to immediately increase the level of postal service provided in
18 the Muldoon Service Area of Anchorage, Alaska.

19 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Jimmy Carter,
20 President of the United States; the Honorable Benjamin F. Bailar, Postmaster
21 General; the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S.
22 Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U. S. Representative, members of the
23 Alaska delegation in Congress; and Mr. Gary Packer, Acting District Manager,
24 U. S. Postal Service.
