BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. Article III, sec. 26, Constitution of the State of Alaska,

10

is amended to read:

SECTION 26. BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS. When a board or commission is

12

at the head of a principal department or a regulatory or quasi-judicial

13

agency or is created to administer either the permanent fund established

14

under sec. 15, art. IX or a renewable resource fund, its members shall

15

be appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by a majority of

16

the members of the legislature in joint session, and may be removed as

17

provided by law. They shall be citizens of the United States. The

18

board or commission may appoint a principal executive officer when

19

authorized by law, but the appointment shall be subject to the approval

20

of the governor.

\* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed

22

before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity

23

with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election

24

laws of the state.
