3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution
6 of the State of Alaska regarding aid to
7 private educational institutions.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Article VII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
10 amended to read:

11 SECTION 1. PUBLIC EDUCATION. The legislature shall by general law
12 establish and maintain a system of public schools open to all children of the
13 State, and may provide for other public educational institutions. Schools
14 and institutions so established shall be free from sectarian control. No
15 money shall be paid from public funds for the direct benefit of any religious
16 [OR OTHER PRIVATE] educational institution.

17 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
18 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
19 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
20 laws of the state.
