3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the World Peace Tax Fund.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the right of conscience is deeply embedded in our American
8 traditions of freedom; and

9 WHEREAS the rights of citizens opposed to war have steadily expanded
10 since the inception of the Republic; and

11 WHEREAS the Congress of the United States is currently considering the
12 World Peace Tax Fund bill which would create a federal trust fund into which
13 taxpayers opposed to war could pay their taxes; and

14 WHEREAS this bill would permit Alaskans who conscientiously oppose war
15 to have their full share of federal taxes used for nonmilitary purposes;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature encourage speedy enact-
17 ment of the World Peace Tax Fund bills, H.R. 4897 and S. 880, by the United
18 States Congress.

19 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Russell B.
20 Long, Chairman, Senate Finance Committee; the Honorable Al Ullman, Chairman,
21 House Ways and Means Committee; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the
22 Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U.S.
23 Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
